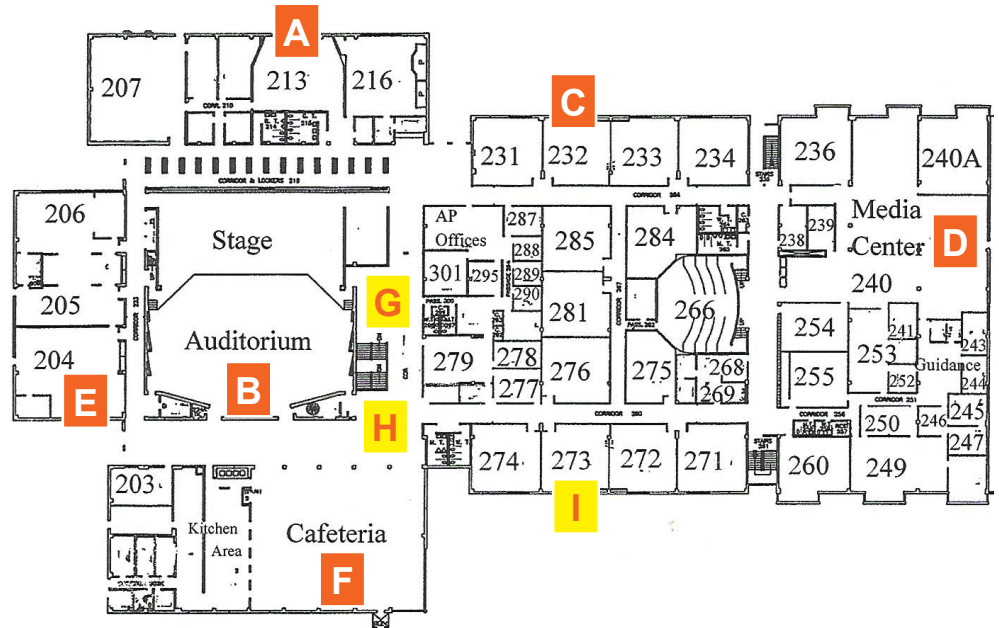

MAP - WILLIAMSPORT HIGH

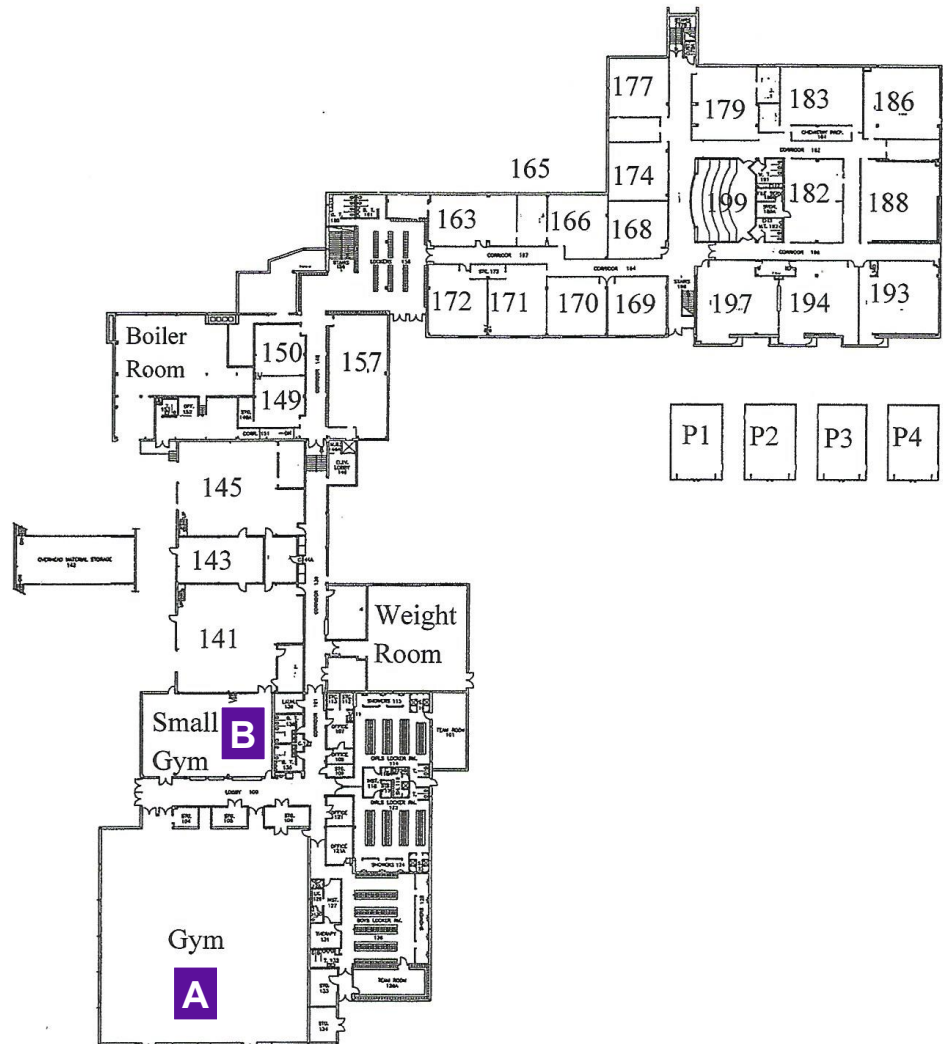
